Our Priorities 2025-26

Priority 1:

Increase the use of data and self-evaluation approaches at all levels.

Priority 2:

Raise attainment in numeracy by adopting a consistent approach to mathematical pedagogy, planning methods and learning, teaching and assessment.

Priority 3:

Embed a whole-school nurturing (attachmentinformed) ethos that promotes positive relationships and supports wellbeing and inclusion.

Priority 4:

Improve pupil attendance by working collaboratively with learning community schools to create a toolkit.

What do we want to achieve? (Outcomes)

- Increased use of attainment analysis tool.
- All tracking meetings to be data focussed, using Fact, Story, Action (FSA) approach.
- Staff Learning Trios established to identify features of highly effective practice.
- New, consistent planning documents to be used by all teaching staff.
- CPA approach used consistently in all stages.
- Interventions delivered to targeted pupils.
- Increased use of resources and supports in all classes.
- In consultation with all stakeholders, a new Positive Relationships policy will be created.
- Circle Framework used in all classes.
- A revised nurture provision established.
- All stakeholders to have increased understanding of SLC's Attachment Strategy and Emotion Coaching.
